## ➤ HOW TO APPLY

- Set Up your Student Account  
Complete the General Scholarship Application  
**Keep in mind the deadline for submitting your completed application with all supporting documentation is March 31st.**
- To maximize your chances of receiving a Foundation scholarship, **answer questions completely.**
- **Read instructional text** appearing throughout the general scholarship application.
- Applicants may work on their applications over time. To ensure that work is saved, click "**Save and Keep Editing**" every 30 minutes.
- Once you complete all questions, click "**Finish and Submit.**"
- Review your student account periodically to check the status of your applications and manage your references.
